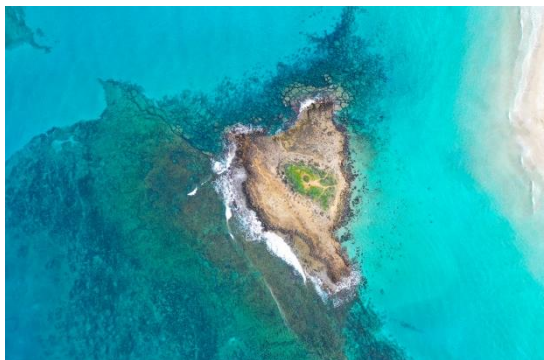

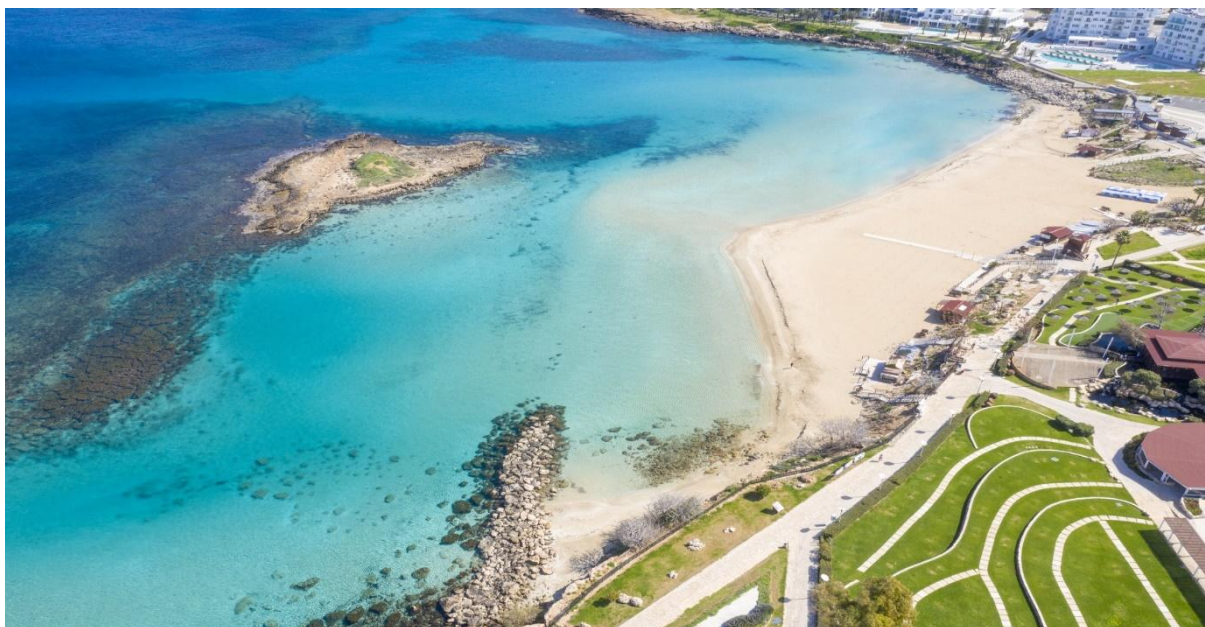

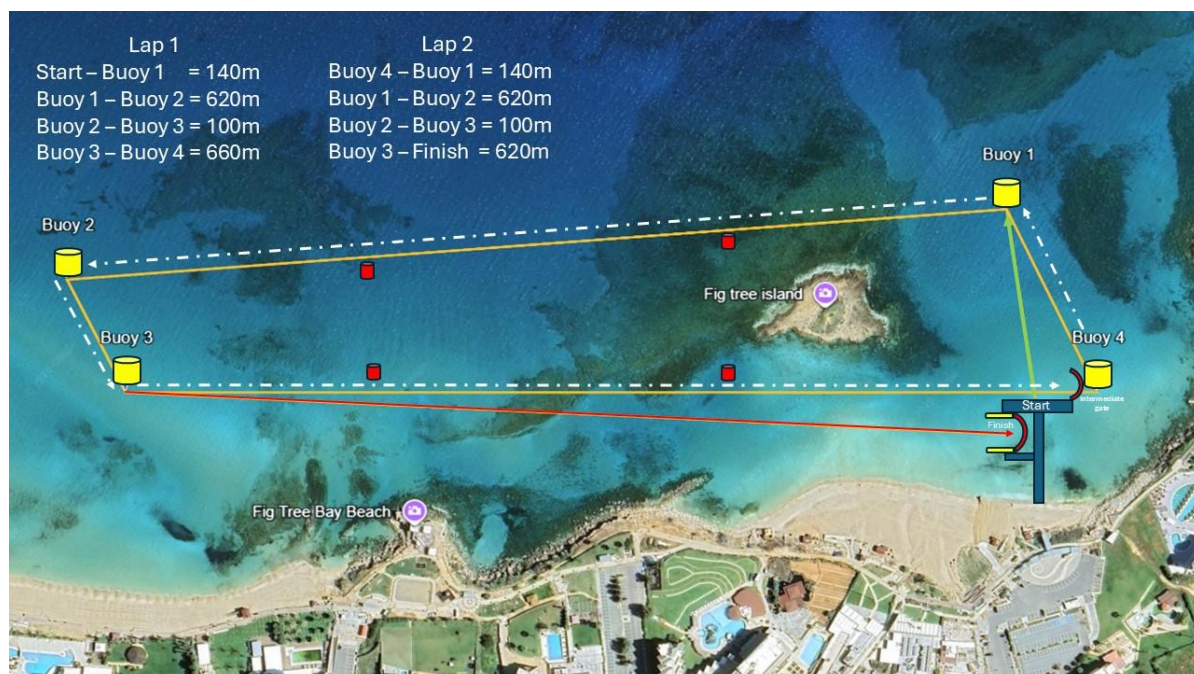

2026 Masters' Open Water Swimming Tour - Leg 1 and 2 - will be organized under the same rules as is stated in each provided bulletin.

2026 Masters' Open Water Swimming Tour - Leg 3 will be organised as part of the European Aquatics Masters Championships. The bulletin will be published separately, and the respective championship rules will apply.

Events

3km Men and Women

Age Categories

20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+.

Age category shall be determined solely based on the athlete's year of birth.

Event Entries, Entry Fees and Accreditation

Competitors are not required to hold membership in a club affiliated with a Member Federation or in a Federation registered with European Aquatics.

Entries may be submitted directly by competitors or by any authorized person until circulated deadline. No amendment is possible after Technical Meeting. There are no restrictions regarding citizenship or residence of competitors.

A participation fee of **€50** must be paid to LOC's account. Once the payment is completed, the fee is non-refundable.

Each competitor may obtain their Accreditation Card upon arrival at the event, following verification of identity. **Release of Liability** should be signed and brought to the Accreditation Centre.

Awards & Prizes

The best three ranked male and female in each category will be awarded with medals.

Master' Open Water Swimming Tour Final Ranking

Participation in all three legs is mandatory for inclusion in the Masters Tour Final Ranking.

Water Temperature

The water temperature shall be measured within 30 minutes before start of race and must be a minimum of 16°C and maximum of 31°C. The water temperature shall be certified by the Safety Officer as measured in as near to the middle of the course as possible at a depth of 40 cm. If multiple measurements are taken, these must be averaged.

Swimwear

All competitors will receive and must wear a brightly coloured numbered cap according to the seeding.

If measured water temperature is below 18°C, the use of wetsuits is compulsory.

All swimsuits (also wetsuit) must be according to World Aquatics rules.

Waves

Competitors will be seeded in waves according to age groups.

Start

Men and Women race shall be organised separated.

OTL (out of time Limit – cut off time)

For the 2026 Masters' Open Water Swimming Tour Leg events, a cut off time of 30 minutes per kilometre may be applied.

The application of cut off times and OTL procedures shall be presented at Technical Meeting.

Technical Meeting

Technical Meeting shall be held at competition venue between **16:00 – 17:00 on Saturday 18th, 2026.**

Training Schedule

Training at competition venue shall be held between **15:00-16:00 on Saturday 18th, 2026.**

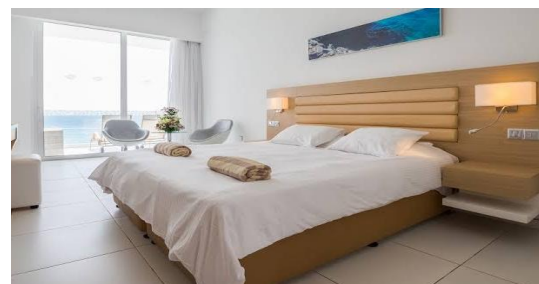
Medal ceremonies will be held right after the race is finished.

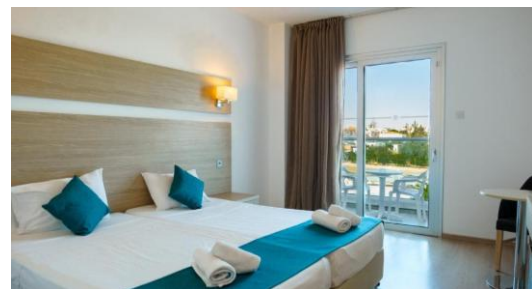
